\*No. Under the following conditions, maintenance for certain items is required independent of the multi information display.

1 If item B appears before one year has passed, inspect for vehicle corrosion every year.

2 When you drive primarily in urban areas that have high concentrations of soot in the air, under dusty conditions, or when the air flow from the heating and cooling system/climate control system becomes weak, replace the filter every 20,000 km (12,500 miles) or every year. (30,000km/18,500 miles for CR-Vs)

4 Driving in mountainous areas at very low/high speeds results in higher transmission temperatures. This required transmission fluid changes more frequently than recommended by the service reminder. If you regularly drive your vehicle under these conditions, have the transmission fluid changed every 50,000 km.
